## **Grants**

We have submitted an application to DVA for refurbishment of the remaining WWI memorial plaques. DVA have advised that our application was due for consideration in late Feb.

During the refurb, an error has been noted on the plaque of Colthup (wrong Battalion). A letter has been sent to the editor of Eumundi Green, to try to find any family of Colthup to obtain family concurrence with changing the plaque. The letter will be published on 18 Mar.



## **Flagpoles**

We have purchased two flagpoles with funds provided by the RSL District Community and Welfare Fund. The flagpoles will be erected at the amphitheatre stage area. Council are installing the flagpoles free of charge. The flagpoles will not be maintained by Council. A maintenance agreement between the Sub Branch, the EHA and Council is being processed – basically, the Sub Branch will be responsible.

## **Arrangements for ANZAC Day**

Following last years ANZAC Day, Council advised of their requirements for future ceremonies. These requirements introduced additional expenses in terms of Traffic Management Plans by accredited organisations, electricity usage and for some Sub Branches, street cleaning. This Sub Branch queried these requirements with the District Branch and the ultimate result was a Commemorative Workshop between Council and the RSL. The outcome of the workshop was very beneficial. From this ANZAC Day onwards, Eumundi only needs to submit a short form event application, does not require a Traffic Management Plan, and will not be charged Council costs (provided the ceremony follows the same format as the previous year). For 2010, this will result in a cost saving of \$318.

The meeting discussed the format of the ceremony, including pre ANZAC Day fund raising opportunities. Fund raising will be undertaken at the markets on the preceeding Wednesday and Saturday.

For Eumundi, the ceremony is a community event with RSL input and participation. For 2010, the RSL is officially the organisation responsible for management of the event and the provider of public liability insurance. The community however provides the co-ordination for the event with RSL assistance as and when required.

## **Re-Union Lunches/Dinners**

As advised in previous newsletters:

The Mudjimba is holding a re-union luncheon on Saturday 20 March at 11:30 for 12:30 @ \$35 per person.

There will be a combined Maroochydore/Yandina/Eumundi RSL Sub Branch Luncheon held at Maroochydore RSL Club on Saturday 24 July 2010. The lunch is open to all members and partners. The cost is



subsidised by the RSL and the expected cost per person is \$42.00. The plan is to have tables of 10.

Members were advised of the purpose of the events and attendees solicited.

### **State Congress Townsville**

The 2010 State Congress will be held at Jupiters Casino, Townsville, from Saturday 18 June 2010 to Sunday 20 June. For Eumundi, the cost will be subsidised by the District Branch and Sub Branch. The District Branch have reserved some rooms at Jupiters. Ken Tongue advised of his availability to attend. He would have the status of delegate.

Note: subsequent to the meeting, his State Congress Registration Form was completed and forwarded to District Branch.

### **Any Other Business**

Membership Recruiting. The meeting discussed possible recruiting ideas including publicity opportunities. For 2010, one member has declined to renew his membership and two new members are currently being processed.

School Scholarships. Discussions with other Sub Branches reveal that for some areas, there is a need for scholarships for the Year 6 to Year 7 transition. This will be looked at.

Sponsored Events. The possibility of sponsoring/conducting events (eg aquatic events) was discussed.

### **Next Meeting**

The next meeting will be held on 22 June 2010 and will be the Annual General Meeting.
